


Pt 3. Minimalistic style.

Definition

 Minimalism is a style employed by many 20th Century artists, using a minimum amount of components such as colour, shape, line and texture.



• When understanding how to achieve minimalism, the rule is to keep it simple. But that doesn't mean it needs to be boring or uninteresting.







• A good place to start might be within geometric shapes found within architecture, which often include a whole wall of re-occurring pattern that can be exploited as a minimalist photo


