


# O. The history of the

#### Brest-Litovsk fortress

# 1. After 3<sup>rd</sup> dividing of the Retch Pospolitaya there was a necessity in defenses on western frontier of the Russian Empire

- 2. Russian government decided to build line of fortresses in the territory of Poland, Belarus and Ukraine. For example:
  - 1) Brest-Litovsk;
  - 2) Nowogeorgiwsk (Modlin);
  - 3) Warszawa;
  - 4) Osoviez;
  - 5) Ivangorod (Demblin).

#### 3. 1836-1842 – building of the fortress in the Brest-Litovsk




#### - The fortress' scheme


#### 4. But inventing of rifling artillery made these fortifications inadequate



## 5. Totleben decided to build ring of fortress around fortress Brest-Litovsk in 1878-1888


#### 6. There were a 9 forts in 1<sup>st</sup> ring of the fortress. Material: brick.





7. But after inventing high-explosive shells that can easily destroy brick constructions, government decided to develop forts and distances between forts.

# 8. There were one new fort and developing of forts IV-IX. There were new casemates, tunnels and caponiers with using concrete.










### 10. Also powder magazines, defensive casernes, artillery batteries were build between forts.





### 11. Appearance and developing of heavy and super-heavy artillery demand militaries to build 2<sup>nd</sup> fortress'



## 12. There were forts "A", "B", "Г", "E", "Ж", "З", "И", "К", "Л", "М", "Н", "О", 38 redoubts and 21 artillery batteries.





#### 13. It appeared in 1909 - 1915





## 14. In 1915 there were few front positions, which were represented by fortified groups around 2<sup>nd</sup> fort's ring.



## 15. But, in 1915 Russian government decided to not defend it. So, half part of objects was destroyed.
