

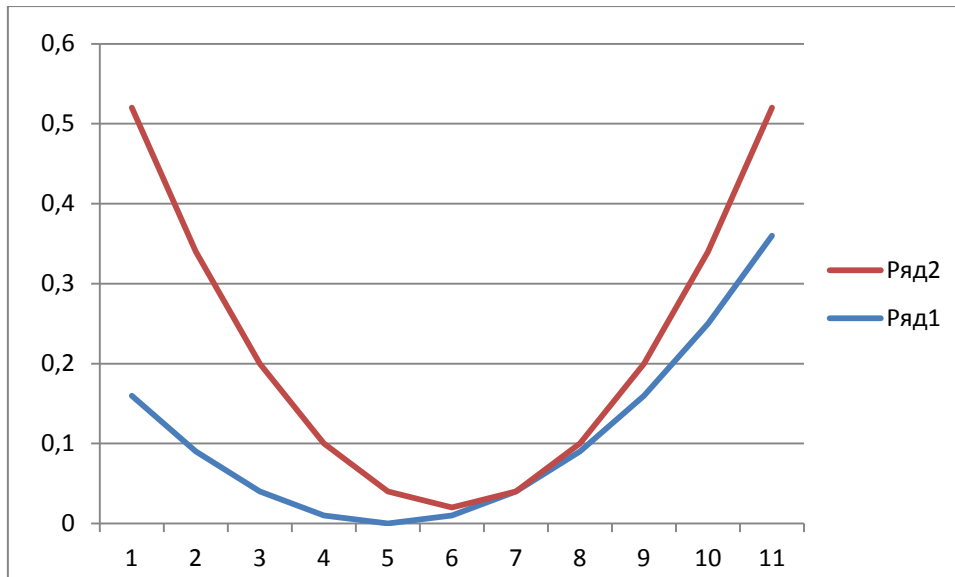
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Function $y=(x-0,4)^2$ and $y=(x-0,6)^2$

Graph of values:

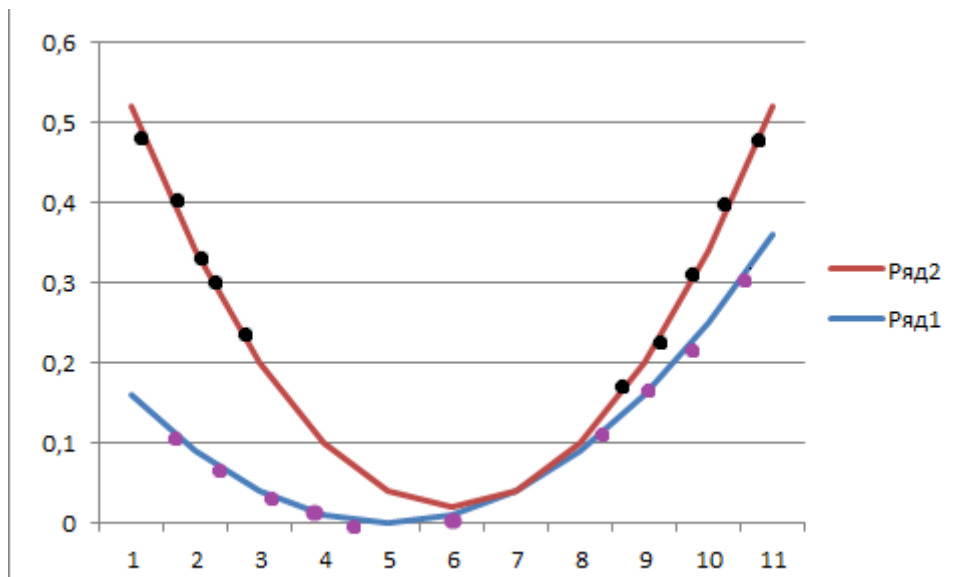
